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SEGS Nominating Committee Duties

The SEGS Nominating Committee is responsible for identifying, communicating with, and encouraging members to accept nominations for annual ballot elections of Secretary, Treasurer, Vice-President, and President.

According to our By-Laws, which are linked to our website, the President, with input from the Nominating Committee, must present to the Society, at least 14 days prior to the annual (4th quarterly/fall) meeting, the names of individuals recommended for election. Therefore, the Nominating Committee Chair should coordinate a meeting(s) or teleconference(s) during the third quarter of the year with committee members to share thoughts regarding candidates.

It's appropriate that the V.P be the Chair, so that he/she has some influence over who is nominated to serve as V.P. when he/she moves into the Presidency, as expected, for organizational consistency.

In this regard, SEGS has traditionally allowed Executive Committee members to serve multiple terms, particularly the Secretary and Treasurer, while we work diligently to identify a new V.P. each year, so the current V.P. may move on to the President and Past-President posts.
